Be proactive about cleaning underground lines

Especially in older neighborhoods with mature trees and shrubs. Water-seeking roots invade, clog, crack and displace old pipelines. Roots may need to be cleared annually to keep the sewer line running freely. Call the Plumbing Source to discuss the best methods for your property.



The main water line connects the public water supply to your property. In Cuyahoga County, most municipalities are financially responsible *only* for the line between curb shut-off and property boundaries.

Factors that cause water line damage

Mostly, it's age. Older pipes can degrade, weaken and crack. Seals can spoil. And extreme temperature changes means years of repeated expansion and contraction. Overly high water pressure can also add stress to your pipes.

Signs you may have a water line leak

- O higher water bills
- O wet areas in the home
- O unexplained outdoor water puddles
- O low water pressure
- O discolored water
- hissing or bubbling sounds from pipes
- O foundational cracks
- O mold and mildew
- O frequent drain clogs
- O bad smells
